

A User's Guide to the JET Course

Welcome to JET! We are so glad that you are looking at ways of using this material.

Firstly, JET is more than a traditional course. In many courses, there are a set number of modules to be completed in a set way over a set number of weeks. However, the scope of the material is much more flexible and is designed so that it may be adapted to your specific context. For example, the videos are short, they may be watched repeatedly, and the Bible Study and Reflection notes can be adapted to suit you – you need not go through every question if you do not wish to. In essence, JET is a resource hub, here to equip you. You may choose to use the JET materials:

- To enhance you own personal understanding
- In a small group setting
- As part of a larger church gathering

Ideas for How to Use JET - Different Tracks

Choose Your Own Track

We recommend completing all the videos <u>before you engage</u> Jewish people with the Gospel. In particular, please ensure that you have thoroughly covered <u>the Care section of videos</u>. Our aim is to share sensitively with understanding, the news of our Jewish Messiah. Nevertheless, you may wish to cherry-pick the contents in an order relevant to you. In this way you may choose your own track through the videos and materials. Please also view Alex's video. This is a standalone segment which outlines many of the principals found in later videos.

A Seasonal Track

Why not have a quarterly break from your usual home group to go through a JET module? You might choose to look at Kingdom in July, Culture in October, Care in January and Calendar in March / April. This would bring you nicely to Easter / Passover time when you may wish to celebrate together or perhaps plan an evangelistic event. See the *20 Practical Pointers* for further ideas.

A Teaching Day Track

Perhaps gathering a group of people together in one full day might work well for you. Why not adapt the seasonal model above into four themed days? This could work either in a home setting or a church setting. Examples of how you might like to arrange things are below. Feel free to supplement with other activities such as worship, prayer or additional Bible study time.

A Linear Track

This will take 12 weeks, (3 months) to run if held consecutively. You may wish to watch the videos followed by a study session together. Alternatively, people could watch the videos in the week before the meeting and then come together to discuss and pray together.
