### 1.4 Tools for You

## **Purpose**

To give some practical ideas and some biblical principals for reaching Jewish people effectively with the Good News.

#### Scriptures

## **Scenario Questions**

- 1) A Jewish friend of yours at work comments that Jesus is just for Gentiles (non-Jews) and that He is not for Jewish people. What would you say in response? Review the videos to help you develop a strong response.
- 2) You are having a coffee with a Jewish friend and during the conversation, you get to talking about why the Bible is significant in your life. What principals would you share with them? Review the videos and the notes to help you formulate an answer that seeks to uphold the Jewishness of the whole Bible.
- 3) Whilst looking in the mirror, can you explain the Gospel with love and care in less than five minutes? How concise can you make it? Can you get the basic points down? Imagine you are saying it to a Jewish person you know.
- 4) You are on a walk with a Jewish family member. The conversation is going well and you get on to the topic of faith and spirituality. They are fairly open. What three messianic prophecies do you think you could share simply? Practice these until you can say them and explain them clearly. Remember to pitch your language and tone of voice in a loving non-judgemental way and steer clear of Christian jargon.
- 5) You are speaking with someone you know well from your Church and you mention JET. However, as you do, you sense that they disapprove, suggesting that Israel failed and that's why God replaced them with the church. How can you correct this thinking? Could you explain that it was actually because of the success of the early Jewish disciples and through their faith in Jesus that we actually believe today? What parts of this section of videos would you explain to them?
